



Rules for Recreational Vehicle Parking

1. Recreational vehicle (RV) overnight parking is available only for Kent Island Yacht Club Members or guests of Members on the grass near "C" Dock. Guests of Members will be welcomed only twice in each calendar year.
2. Members must reserve spaces in advance and must sign in and pay the appropriate fee at the yacht club office upon arrival. Members must be present to sign in their guests. Members are responsible for the conduct, charges incurred, and dress of their guests.
3. Upon sign in, the reverse side of this form must be filled out completely by the RV owner, who must post it in an area visible from the outside of the RV.
4. Overnight parking of a Member's RV is \$25/night, which includes water and 30A electricity. Guest overnight RV parking is \$1/foot plus \$5/ night for electricity.
5. Maximum occupancy is seven RVs. Special exceptions for occupancy and guests may only be made by the Fleet Captain, such as for the annual *Thunder on the Narrows* or other special events.
6. The maximum stay is seven days. At the end of that period, the vehicle must be removed from the property for at least seven days, after which it may be returned for another seven days, if space is available and not reserved.
7. No waste water may be discharged on the grounds or in the water. Vehicles will have to leave the grounds to dump holding tanks (the nearest dump station is the Queen Anne's County Sewage Disposal Facility near the Bay Bridge. Call (401) 643 - 3535 for more information).
8. Additional vehicles must be parked in the parking lot area, not on the grass, unless there is no space in the parking lot. No trailers of any kind are permitted in the RV parking area. Towed car dollies should be stored on the west side of the driveway near other trailers.
9. The only items that may be left outside the RV must be contained within the "awning footprint" of the RV. The area around the RV should be kept neat and clean as if it were in a yacht club.
10. Pets are allowed, but must be inside the RV if the owners are not present. No outdoor pens may be used. Please walk your pets to the pet walk area, which is the grassy area west of the entrance driveway, and clean up after your pet.
11. All trash should be bagged and placed in the dumpster provided for that purpose. Absolutely no trash or garbage should be stored outside the RV, particularly at night, since it attracts rodents and other wildlife.
